That task duration plays an important role in vocabulary learning.



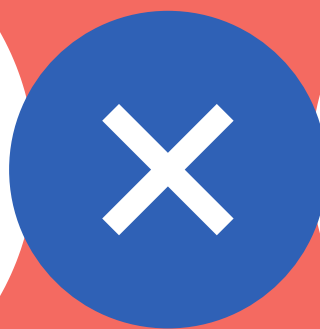
Knowledge of the sensory effects of writing will reinforce the learning-writing relationship

Multi-selection: 95

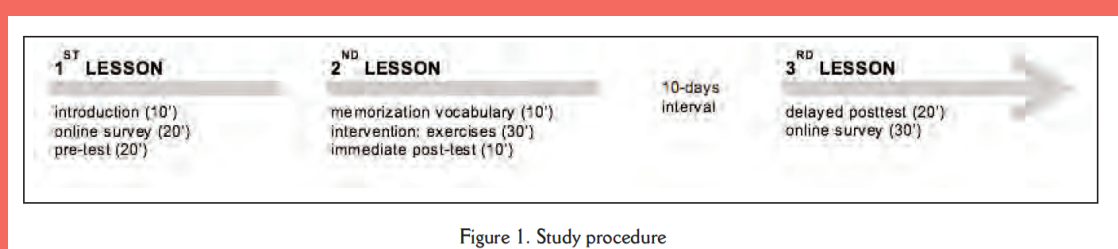


Figure 1. Study procedure

## CONCLUSIONS



The study demonstrates that each of the three practice groups did indeed acquire vocabulary



Students who spent more time learning the vocabulary scored better over time than the multiple-choice group.  
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Students scored higher in the multiple-choice part of the tests.  
The students scored better on multiple choice tests, which is why this method is characterised by a lower level of demand.

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
