RISK'S PERCEPTION: The autonomous use is related to interventions related to cybersafety. The Internet provides opportunities but also exhibits youth to risks such as CYBERATTACKS or CYBERVICTIMISATION.

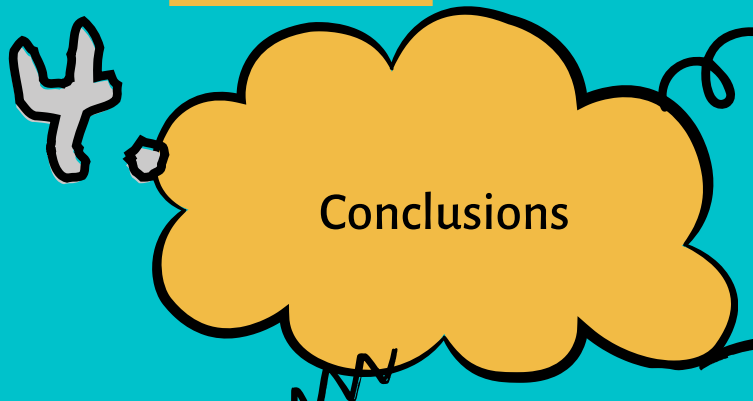
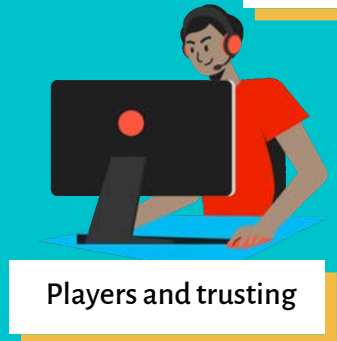
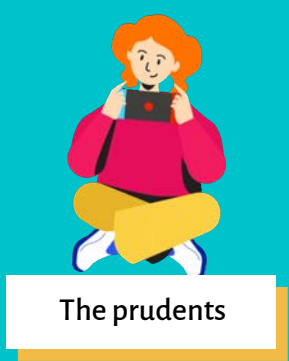
FAMILIAR CONTEXT: Low performance and attention's problems are the consequences of cyberbullying. The profile of the bully is related to conflictive environments.

THE USE OF TIC: Connection is almost permanent in young Spanish people.

OBJECTIVES AND HYPOTHESIS: Analyse the younger users and describe their behaviors and familiar mediation.



A study of 865 schooled children from Community of Madrid of 9 schools in different contexts



The perception of risk is present on problematic behaviour related to health, where the family is essential.

Results:
42% of <<prudent>> profiles: healthier practices

To detect, identify and react to problematic situations while using the internet and create awareness over existing risks.

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
