## INTRODUCTION

**Risks on the Internet,** actions and behaviours in adolescence are characterised by being on the borderline of risk or prohibition, a characteristic that is also reflected in their use of the Internet.



**Adolescence,** most of the adolescents agree on the low level of parental supervision and the lack of usage schedules.

## OBJECT AND METHOD

The objective of this study is to determine the frequency of these risky actions related to content accessed by minors and downloads made on the Internet, analysing this frequency according to gender, age and context (Spain, Italy and Greece).

**Ex post facto descriptive, cross-sectional, quantitative and exploratory research.**

**N= 2,529 participants aged 10-17 years from different Communities.**

**Online questionnaire entitled "Digital Anomie".**

The results therefore indicate that, despite the cross-cultural nature of the study, this variable does not explain the observed differences and similarities.
